Service Reductions in Response to FY 2008 Orange County Funding

- FY 2008 budget included a \$2.5 million reduction in service.
- Changes proposed here for August 17, 2008 implementation save an estimated \$726,000 annually.
- A second phase is being developed for implementation in December.
- Further service reductions due to FY 2009 funding levels are now anticipated, as much as \$8 million due to fuel, paratransit service demand, and labor agreement cost increases.






Response to Public Outreach

- LYNX held one public workshop on May 13, and two public hearings on June 17.
- 112 people attended the public workshop.
- 109 people attended the 2 public hearings.
- Staff modified four proposals in response to comments concerning Links 9, 14, 49, and 443.







Average

- Discontinues
 Virginia/Ferncreek:
 Orange Colonial
- 29 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/4 mile to Mills (Link 125)






Changes to Link 13



- Discontinue Bumby:
 Colonial Corrine
- Re-routed 13
 replaces Link 23 on
 Maguire behind
 Fashion Square
- 75 passengers at risk
- walk < ½ mile to Colonial (Links 28, 29, 30)



Discontinue Links 14 and 16



- Discontinues
 Edgewater/Lakeview:
 Princeton Orange
- 35 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/2 mile to Princeton (Link 125) or Colonial (Links 30, 48, 49)



Discontinue Much of Link 14



- Discontinues Clay:
 Orange Minnesota
- 14 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/4 mile to
 Orange (Link 102) or
 Minnesota (Link 14)
- New Link 14 between Calvary Towers on Minnesota to Winter Park Village

Discontinue Link 16



- Discontinues
 Monroe –Elvin Bennett
- 38 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/4 mile to
 Lee (Link 443) or 17-92 (Links 1, 9, 102)
- The Meadows
 Apartments lose
 "front-door" service



Discontinue Link 16



- Discontinues
 Edgewater: Fairbanks Maury
- 48 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/2 mile to Maury (Link 125) or Fairbanks (Link 23)
- Haven of Hope at Delridge is 2/10's mile from new closest stop (shelter proposed)



Streamline Link 48



- Discontinues Balboa-Bramblewood-Willowwood-Hiawassee
- 344 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/2 mile to Hiawassee (Link 37)



Streamline Link 49



- Discontinues Balboa-Hastings
- 83 passengers at risk
- walk < 1/2 mile to Pine Hills (Link 49) or Powers (Link 48)
- Created this adjustment rather than discontinuing service to North Lane.
